Our Mission

Cancer Navigators, a community-based nonprofit organization founded in 2002 as Many Streams Healing Systems, serves as a complement to the medical expertise of cancer care providers by guiding those affected by cancer toward a better understanding of diagnosis and care and connecting them with needed resources in their journey – free of charge.

The Cancer Navigators office has remained open throughout the COVID-19 pandemic and is meeting patients however they are most comfortable - via phone, Zoom, or in-person in a socially distanced space. Staff continues to provide patients additional supplies to reduce outings and coordinate food pantry deliveries to patients with the greatest transportation challenges.

Services Provided


January - December 2021:

- 2,502 Patient Encounters for Social Support Services CN patient navigators assist patients with insurance and financial services, completing applications for Medicare, Medicaid, Disability, and SSI; also researching potential patient grants based on specific cancer diagnosis and employment history.
- 1,281 Encounters for Food Pantry Referrals and Liquid Nutrition
- 494 Patient encounters for Received Supplies (Medical Supplies, Wigs, Caps)
- **583** Patient encounters for Received Transportation Assistance (Gas Cards/Bus Vouchers)
- **144** Patient encounters for Received Outside Grants (monetary value of outside grants received- \$104,869.19)
- 1,058 Patient/Caregiver encounters for Received Counseling with Cancer Navigators' Licensed Clinical Social Worker

Here for You in 2022

The Cancer Navigators office remains open and we are here to serve patients in-person or over the phone, however they feel most comfortable. Cancer Navigators also continues to provide the following services free of charge:

Social Support Services - CN navigators assist patients with insurance and financial services completing applications for Medicare, Medicaid, Disability, and SSI; researching patient grants based on diagnosis and employment history

Counseling - A licensed clinical social worker is on staff to counsel patients

Complementary Care Program -

Acupressure, Music Therapy, Stress Management

Virtual Retreats - To renew, connect and learn

Transportation Assistance - Gas cards or bus vouchers to assist with transportation to treatments




Supplies - Medical supplies (ostomy, pull-ups, wipes, bed pads), and wigs, caps, hats, scarves and other handmade donations that provide comfort

Nutrition - Referrals to food pantries; Liquid nutrition is available to patients undergoing treatment and struggling to eat
