Cancer Navigators has experienced an increase in patients in 2022 with many in worse health and financial circumstances than in previous years. Over 90% of Cancer Navigators' patients are classified as low-income, and from January - June, Cancer Navigators provided 2,421 free resources and services to cancer patients in northwest Georgia and northeast Alabama, distributing \$20,675 in transportation assistance. Transportation and nutrition remain top barriers to cancer care and tremendous needs for patients. ## 15 Ways Cancer Navigators Helps Cancer Patients

Cancer Navigators assesses the needs of a patient's mind, body, and spirit, and a personalized plan is created using patient navigators. All resources and services are free of charge. Cancer Navigators continues to meet patients however they are most comfortable, whether that be via phone, Zoom, or in-person in a socially distanced space, and increasing the amount of supplies given to reduce patients' outings.





Support from a licensed clinical social worker to help patients understand and navigate complex insurance, healthcare, and financial support programs (e.g., completing applications for Medicare, Medicaid, Disability, and SSI and researching patient grants based on cancer diagnosis and employment history).
